
A 4 Step Approach to Documentation Review









Step One: First, we catalogued all current and proposed programs and initiatives

Step Two:

...Then, we determined the alignment of each program and initiative with the goals and strategies of the proposed strategic plan

Step Three:

...Next, we used this information to assess the risk (impact and probability of success) of each individual initiative

Step Four:

...Finally, we analyzed the gaps between the initiatives and the proposed strategic plan

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
