
Personalize the I Do, We Do, You Do

Personalizing learning



Personalizing I Do, We Do, You Do

- Identify common instructional activities and practices that happen in a normal week
- 2. Add one activity or practice per post-it note **AND**
- 3. Color code them as I Do, We Do, You Do.





Design a lesson that introduces a new idea or skill.

- Sequence activities from left to right
- Feel free to add additional activities, just continue to color code them as I Do, We Do, You Do





Redesign that lesson so that it does NOT start with I Do.

 How can students explore an idea or skill before a formal mini-lesson?





Add student reflection to different activities in that review lesson.


 For those activities, add a Reflection post-it activity on top of the existing post-it.





Include an opportunity to review work with a small group of students.

- Side-by-side post-it notes show activities occurring simultaneously
- Decide how the teacher will know which students to pull
