Our Curriculum Audit/Development Process includes two parts:

Part 1: Curriculum Analysis:

- Classroom Visitations: Analyzes instructional practices, level of student engagement, instructional strategies and delivery. Examines the connection between written, taught and assessed elements.
- Staff Interviews: May include individual and/or focus group formats with teachers and administrators.
- PLC Curriculum Survey: Canvasses a number of curricular elements and provides a data base for discussion.
 Also creates a set of metrics for progress monitoring.

Part: 2: Curriculum Improvement/Development

We will create a curriculum review process and protocol as well as start work with "filling gaps" and strengthening current curriculum. This includes aligning assessments, fine-tuning learning targets, enhancing questioning techniques and designing strategies and activities for higher levels of student cognition and engagement.
